

Australian Dental Association WA Br. (ADAWA) financial assistance to dental auxiliary volunteers

ADAWA funds have been designated for the specific purpose of providing financial assistance to dental auxiliaries wishing to volunteer for your organisation. It is envisaged these funds would assist someone who would otherwise not have the personal resources to undertake volunteerism for your organisation. It is anticipated the funds would assist, either in full or in part with travel, accommodation and incidental expenses specific to a volunteer project.

The volunteer organisation is requested to formally nominate the volunteer to ADAWA Executive following your organisation's own interview and internal vetting processes. There is an expectation on your organisation to submit a detailed submission as to why the applicant should receive funding as well as guidance as to the amount of funding required. ADAWA Executive will be the final arbiter as to whether the application is accepted and the amount of funding to be provided.

ADAWA make no demands on prerequisites such previous experience, education and training, additional training that maybe required to fulfil the requirements of the position or Working with Children Checks and/or Police Clearances.

ADAWA stipulates that nominees employed in private practice in WA be sponsored by an ADAWA member or be employees of Dental Health Services WA or the Oral Health Centre of WA.
